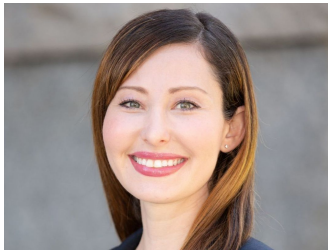

Catch This: Trout-Catching Season at Irvine Lake

Supervisor Wagner tossed the first "Trout" into an Orange County lake on December 3, 2019, and named him Mike: go Angels! Over 4,000 lbs of Nebraska Tailwalkers and rainbow trout flowed into the lake from trucks. Fish were supplied by two hatcheries: one based in Apple Valley, CA, and one from Nebraska. For the first time in three years, local anglers will have this outdoor recreational resource available.

Since becoming Supervisor this year, one of Don Wagner's greatest joys was his role in reopening Irvine Lake for the public to access on August 17, 2019.

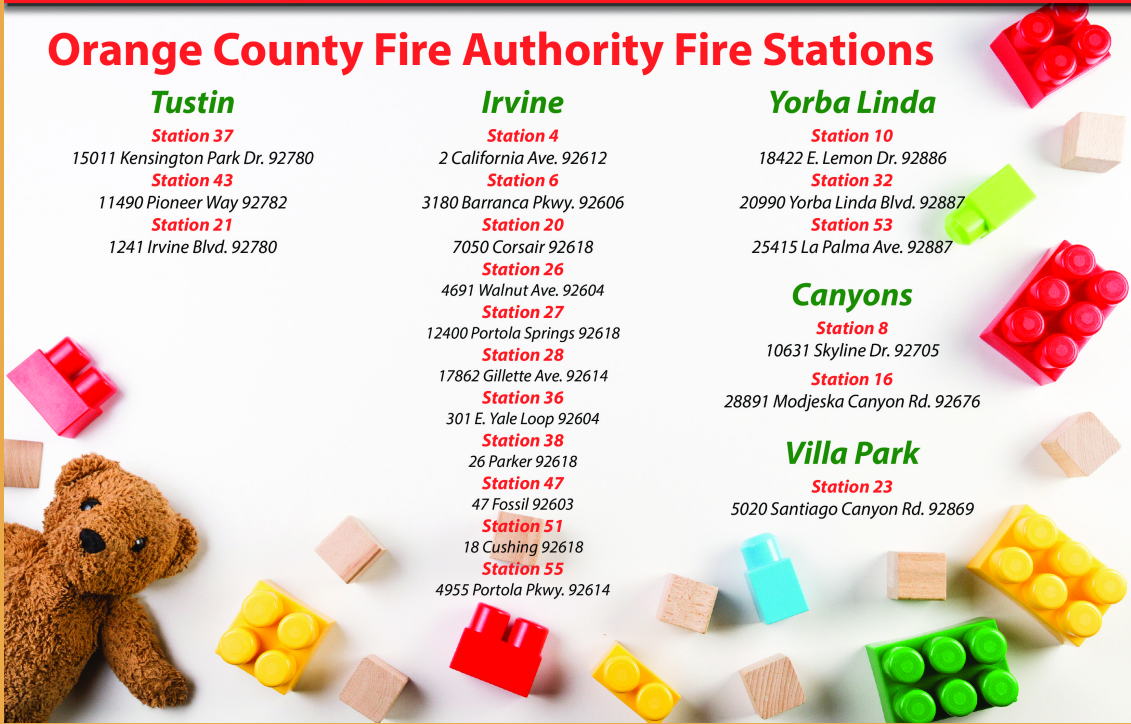

mudslides and debris flows.

- Cleaned out drains and installed sandbags around road shoulders and drains to prevent flooding.
- Silverado Canyon Bridge clearing maintenance and erosion repairs at two bridges.
- Repairs of Santiago Creek along Santiago Canyon Road at Jackson Ranch.
- Canyon Roads Bladed for proper drainage (Modjeska, Modjeska Grade, Live Oak, Trabuco Canyon)
- Completed roadway repairs and installed Earthbind product along Trabuco Creek Road.
- Removed material deposited from last debris flows along Trabuco Creek to allow ample flows under bridges and crossings.
- Staged equipment and materials in the Canyons for quick deployment during emergencies, mud/debris flows, and rain events.
- Modjeska and Portola stockpile sites replenished with sandbags, sand, signs, barricades, and K-rails.

Nineteen grand jurors will take the oath of office on July 1, 2020 for a one-year term.

The role of a Grand Jury differs substantially from that of a trial jury, it is a fulltime assignment. About 80% of the Orange County Grand Jury's time is spent in its civil watchdog role, investigating local government agencies. In the Grand Jury's criminal role, it participates in some criminal indictment and investigation hearings, not jury trials. Grand Jury proceedings are closed to the public.
