


FINALLY, BIPARTISAN BUY-IN FOR OC VETERANS' CEMETERY AT GYPSUM CANYON!











Anaheim Hills — For the first time, a bipartisan agreement is building toward designating a cemetery for Orange County veterans in Anaheim Hills now that a deal to establish one in Irvine has fizzled. The County has a sprawling 280 acres located near Route 91 and the 241 Toll Road at Gypsum Canyon in Anaheim Hills; it's envisioned as OC's future Veterans cemetery site once Sacramento allocates funding to survey the land.

"A regional effort, all of us moving together, is what is required to get this done. We fought to protect that democracy, and now we will access it. We will be talking to those who oppose us. God bless you all, we are going to take this hill," said Nick Berardino from the Veterans Alliance of Orange County.

Chairman of the Orange County Veterans Memorial Park Foundation Bill Cook said, "It's going to be spectacular. This is a beautiful site. I want to thank everyone when we reached out for support, which came out in a flood. Thank you all."

Phil Fuchs, a U.S. Air Force Veteran, said, "I have lived in the Great Park area in Irvine and we would have been impacted by a site there. It would have been a terrible situation. I love the Anaheim Hills site, it's a beautiful place, let's make this a reality."

Anaheim City Councilmember Trevor O'Neil will be bringing a resolution to the Anaheim City Council at the end of the month to show support for the Gypsum Canyon site.

Jose Guevarra, Representative for Congressman Lou Correa said, "Thank you for making the OC Veterans cemetery a reality. I hope to share the privilege as an OC resident to have a final resting place for our Veterans."

Supervisor Wagner noted Congressman Correa has advocated from the beginning to have a Veterans cemetery at Gypsum Canyon in Anaheim Hills. On behalf of our Third District, Supervisor Wagner said he hopes to see a cemetery site for the heroes that fought for our great country.

Orange County District Attorney Todd Spitzer shared he and Supervisor Do proposed the site in 2018 and said, "I will be damned if I turn my back on the individuals that provided our freedoms, this flag, this country, this nation, this state, this County, and I will never ever, ever, turn my back on them."

Chairman Andrew Do said, "With Irvine no longer feasible as a site for a Veterans cemetery, I am proud to support the Gypsum Canyon Site as the new location for a cemetery for Orange County's Veterans. I hope everyone in Orange County gets behind this site so that we can move from plans to action as soon as possible."

"I picture Arlington Cemetery and that hallowed ground when I look at our [Anaheim Hills]; it is a model. At this site, we can echo Arlington, and thank our veterans for the service they've given to the United States and the entire world. The men and women who serve and spread that good deserve a dignified spot to be buried. The Gypsum Canyon site is that spot," said Supervisor Don Wagner.

A Veterans' cemetery in Orange County <u>would not be possible without consensus</u> from elected officials at the County, State, and Federal levels. Supervisor Wagner wants to thank everyone who attended the press conference and for the growing leadership who offered support to our Veteran community.
