WHAT'S HAPPENING



ORANGE COUNTY - The Transportation Corridor Agencies (TCA) is *beefing* up fire safety...with conservation cattle grazing. Also known as targeted grazing, the use of grazing livestock is an effective way to improve and maintain the quality of our outdoor biodiversity. Supervisor Wagner serves as a Director at TCA and supports the program.

OC's cattle grazing program concluded its first year of a three-year pilot program at the Agencies' Live Oak Plaza Conservation Area. Grazing occurs up to three times annually and lasts two to three weeks per event. The first year of the program achieved its early goals:

- Increased bare ground cover
- Decreased invasive non-native vegetation cover
- Decreased dry vegetation, which in turn decreases fuel for fires
- Reduced the non-native annual weed seed bank

Live Oak Plaza, located in Trabuco Canyon northeast of the 241 Toll Road, contains valuable oak woodlands, riparian and coastal sage scrub; a natural habitat for some of our local endangered species. The site also serves as a corridor for animals to travel amongst the Cleveland National Forest, O'Neill Regional Park, and Whiting Ranch Wilderness Park.

While other cities and agencies use different livestock for grazing, such as goats, TCA is the only agency in Orange County to use cattle. This is because cattle graze specifically on non-native annual grasses and forbs that clear the way for native

species to flourish, which include coastal sage scrub, native perennial grasses, and annual forbs.

TCA received industry recognition for its Conservation Grazing Pilot Program. Most recently, the Orange County Branch of the American Society of Civil Engineers recognized the program as its 2021 Outstanding Wildfire Hardening Project of the Year.

We must do all we can to prepare for fire season. A special thank you to TCA for its commitment to improving Orange County's open spaces.

YORBA LINDA – Team Wagner Field Representative, Al Tello, spoke at the Yorba Linda Chamber Legislative Luncheon on behalf of Supervisor Wagner to provide a County update. Public safety is a priority for Supervisor Wagner; recently, he brought new policies to Orange County, including creating the Safe Zones Program at Sheriff substations, which offers 24-7 video-taped areas for e-commerce transactions or child custody exchanges.

At the luncheon, attendees learned about the state-mandated Housing Element, which outlines the City's plan for meeting the community's housing needs over the next eight years (2021-2029).

The Yorba Linda Chamber of Commerce is dedicated to growing local businesses by cultivating relationships among members, residents and government, encouraging community involvement, and fostering economic growth. Supervisor Wagner supports our local businesses and ensures representatives from his office are available at Yorba Linda Chamber events.



MISSION VIEJO – Music is a great way to connect people and the community; there do not need to be any words to understand or enjoy the benefits of music. Supervisor Wagner has ensured our local Arts & Culture scene could survive during the COVID closures by allocating Third District Art Grant Funds to various groups, including the Pacific Symphony. Last week, he joined families, children, and neighbors for the Symphony's free "Prelude in the Park" festival in Mission Viejo with Mayor Wendy Bucknum and City leadership. Because improving OC's quality of life is a priority for Supervisor Wagner, he continues to find opportunities to support creative outlets in the Third District.

CalOptima will be onsite to check Medi-Cal eligibility, issue \$25 Member Health Rewards to eligible members and host a resource table.

The County of Orange Social Services Agency will be on-site to provide Medi-Cal, CalFresh and CalWORKS enrollment.
